FOLLOWING THE MAIN PLANNED CONTENTS:

- Practical methods of trouble shooting and analysis to qualify and quantify troubles' relevant seriousness and impact on plant's working and safety.
- Education of Trainers within the park in charge with the coordination of the activities of trouble shooting and analysis.
- Methods of selection of trouble countermeasures by means of Preventive Maintenance Plans tailored to the specific needs of the plant in question and therefore far from being generic and costly.
- Analytical identification of the technical and economic priorities to implement modifications and improvements and evaluate relevant economic impact (Costs and Benefits Analysis).
- Methods to set up a direct link/connection with the designers of the manufacturer (Antonio Zamperla spa) to optimize plant Maintainability: easier inspections/diagnosis/repairs and predisposition to advanced prevention.
- RCM approach (Reliability Centered Maintenance approach) in view of creating an organized context of information exchange with the manufacturer (Antonio Zamperla spa)
- Methods of computerized issuing of requests of intervention.
- Methods of monitoring the level of service by means of appropriate numerical indicators of performance to control and define objectives.
- Team work analysis of real cases of common interest and of specific cases reported directly by the participants.
- Methods of technical report writing: identification of the methods most suitable for the different levels of consignees.

Entrance Qualifications

- Admission to the course is not conditional to specific requirements although a technical high-school diploma or a university degree with some knowledge of maintenance basics represent for a preferential background.
- The course will be in English, so a basic knowledge of this language is required as a minimum.
- Maximum number of students: 15.
- Entrance requests to be sent to Antonio Zamperla SpA as pre-registration forms within 10th September 2015 shall be evaluated by a dedicated committee together with the relevant resumes.

The intensive course will last one week.
